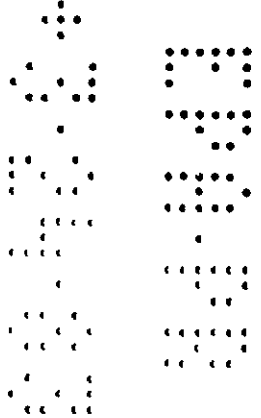

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, State or Local procedures.

Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and Local procedures.

⑨ Space Spray to Kill Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Flying Moths: Dilute three parts of Concentrate with 97 parts of water (in case of dilution for packaging ready-to-use products, use distilled water or deionized water only). Mix thoroughly until a uniform, clear emulsion forms. Mist all parts of the room or area at a dosage of one fluid ounce of diluted spray per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Do not remain in treated area. Ventilate the area after treatment is complete. Repeat as needed.

⑩ Contact Spray to Kill Roaches, Waterbugs, Crickets and the Exposed Forms of Crawling Grain Pests: Dilute four parts of Concentrate with 96 parts of water (in case of dilution for packaging ready-to-use products, use distilled water or deionized water only). Mix thoroughly until a uniform, clear emulsion forms. For roaches, waterbugs, and crickets, apply as a coarse spray to all cracks and crevices in woodwork, underneath sinks, dark places behind pipes and all places where these insects nest, contacting as many insects as possible with the spray. Repeat applications as often as necessary. For grain weevils, cadelles, grain moths, flour beetles and grain mites, apply as a coarse spray to all infested surfaces, insect hiding places and insect runways at the rate of one gallon of diluted spray on 750 square feet of area. Repeat when necessary.

⑪ Contact Spray to Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: Dilute four parts of Concentrate to with 96 parts of water (in case of dilution for packaging ready-to-use products, use distilled water or deionized water only). Mix thoroughly until a uniform, clear emulsion forms. Apply as a coarse spray to infested areas such as pet resting places and areas of floor and floor coverings (such as carpet) where these pests may be present. Use at the rate of one gallon per 750 square feet of area to be treated. Pet's old bedding should be discarded and replaced with clean fresh bedding after treatment. Do not apply directly to pet. Repeat as needed.

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water.
