DANGER

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

Coal Tar Creosote is highly penetrative, and may be applied with spray or brush in two or more flowing coats. Fence posts and all wood to be used in soil contact situations should be free of bark, dry and well seasoned, and should be treated by the dip method for at least 48 hours. Frequent inspections and retreatment may be necessary to maintain protection from fungal decay. May be used for control of fungal rot and mildew in timber products.

Use only on exterior woods such as heavy lumber, fence posts and fence rails.

This product is not suitable for wood intended to be painted.

Do not use treated wood where it may contact food, potable water, dairy animals, livestock or living plants, or where frequent or prolonged skin contact may occur.
