The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Since there is no light petroleum distillate in this product, we suggest the following revision to the "If swallowed" advice, however, if your toxicological data suggests otherwise, please submit a draft Statement of Practical Treatment for prior approval:

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with a finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

2. Add "Artificial" before "respiration" in the "If inhaled" advice.
3. Add "Remove contaminated clothing" to the beginning of the "If on skin" advice.
4. It is noted that your current submission does not contain reference to a technical bulletin as was the case of the March 22, 1983 submission by Wells Chemicals (copy enclosed for reference). Is there any guide or specific instructions for formulators using your product?

5. Is your technical sold in plastic containers? This is the implication based on your choice of container disposal statement.
6. You may delete items from the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section that appear in the Statement of Practical Treatment. Specifically, delete "If the material gets into eyes" through "with soap and water."
7. Relocate the "In case of spillage" advice from the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section to the Directions for Use or the general section of the Storage and Disposal advice (after "do not contaminate.")
8. Change Warning Symptoms to Poisoning Symptoms in the heading Note to Physician and in the last subheading at the bottom of the Statement of Practical Treatment.
9. Revise the Environmental Hazards section to read in total:

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters unless in accordance with a National Pollution Discharge Elimination System Permit. For guidance, contact your Regional Office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

10. The respirator advice should be revised to reflect the current names of the regulating agencies as follows:

Wear a respirator jointly approved by the Mine Safety and Health Administration (MSHA) and the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) for pesticide application under the provisions of 30 CFR Part 11 for protection against dichlorvos.

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
