Your Application Dated March 1st, 1984

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Revise "For Manufacturing Purposes Only" to read "An insecticide for formulating use only."
2. Change "Active Ingredients" to "Active Ingredient."
3. Since the product does not contain solvents that might pose an aspiration hazard, the Agency suggests the following revision to the "If swallowed" advice; however, if your toxicological data suggest otherwise, please submit a draft Statement of Practical Treatment for prior approval:

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with a finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

4. Change "Call a physician if irritation persists" to "Call a physician immediately" in the "If in eyes" advice.

5. Repeat the signal word Warning under "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" and add as the first sentence: "May be fatal if swallowed." You may delete the "In case of skin contact" and "if in eyes" advice since this will appear in the statement of Practical Treatment.
6. Add "and before eating or smoking" to "Wash thoroughly after handling."
7. Revise the Environmental Hazards section to read in total:

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, or public waters unless in accordance with an NPDES permit. For guidance, contact your Regional Office of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

8. Please submit an updated Confidential Statement of Formula for this product showing current suppliers and other requested product information. Based on available information, the Physical or Chemical Hazards section could be deleted since there is no flammable solvent and the lindane crystals themselves presumably do not pose a fire risk.

The advice to store above 32°F already appears in the Storage and Disposal section.

9. Revise the Pesticide Disposal text to read:

Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

10. Delete the subsection General and its associated text from the Storage and Disposal advice.
11. Relocate the "Storage" subsection to appear as the second item of the Storage and Disposal advice, after the Prohibitions section.

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

If you hold a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a Special Local Needs registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until ~~April 30~~^{July 31}, 1984. After that
