2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 47952-4."
- b. Submit the EPA Accession Number for the analytical methods and storage stability data or submit the results of analyses for the active ingredients from three production batches of your product. Test the product at the beginning when freshly prepared, and at monthly intervals for a period of 1 year under storage conditions similar to those to which the product will be exposed during marketing and distribution in channels of trade and during use. You cannot reference storage stability data for a concentrate or intermediate that you use as a source of the active ingredient contained in your product.
- c. Delete the word "Ultra" from the product name. Superlative phrases, or words with respect to product performance are not acceptable.
- d. The phrase should read, "Call physician or Poison Control Center."

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product
in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.

This product will kill fleas up to 14 days and ticks up to 7 days on dogs and cats.

Spray the animal from a distance of 8-12 inches. Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and under the body. Fluff the hair as you spray so the spray will penetrate to the skin. The spray should wet the ticks thoroughly. Do not spray in face, eyes or on genitalia. Repeat as needed.

For cats apply at the rate of 1 second per pound of body weight. For dogs apply at the rate of 2 seconds per pound of body weight for thin or short-haired dogs and up to 8 seconds per pound of body weight for heavy or long-haired dogs.

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Do not spray in eyes, face or on genitalia. Do not use on nursing puppies or kittens under 3 months of age.
