**IN SOAKING SUDS**—Add 1 tablespoon of this sodium hypochlorite solution per gallon of water. Mix well. Add soap or detergent. Immerse laundry. Wash. Rinse.  
**IN WASHING SUDS**—Add 1 tablespoon of this sodium hypochlorite solution per gallon of water. Mix well. Add soap or detergent. Immerse laundry in automatic washers into which laundry is placed before the recommended amount of this sodium hypochlorite solution is added into washer after laundry is immersed.

**FOR SANITIZING GLASSES, DISHES AND SILVERWARE:**  
Immerse for 30 seconds in solution of 2 ozs. of this sodium hypochlorite solution per gallon of water in final rinse tank of dishwashing procedure employed in hot or cold water.

Eating and drinking utensils properly washed and submerged in solution prepared as directed, will be sanitized in accordance with requirements.

**LAUNDRING IN TUB, WASHING MACHINE OR AUTOMATIC WASHER:**

**IN SOAKING SUDS**—Add 1 tablespoon of this sodium hypochlorite solution for each gallon of water. Mix well. Add soap or detergent. Immerse laundry 11 min. to overnight. Wash. Rinse.

**IN WASHING SUDS**—Add 1 tablespoon of this sodium hypochlorite solution for each gallon of water. Mix well. Add soap or detergent. Immerse laundry. Wash. Rinse. (For automatic washers into which laundry is placed before water is added, dilute recommended amount of this sodium hypochlorite solution in qt. of water and pour into washer after laundry is immersed.)

**FOR SANITIZING GLASSES, DISHES AND SILVERWARE:**

Immerse for 30 seconds in solution of 2 ozs. of this sodium hypochlorite solution to 4 gallons of water in final rinse tank of dishwasher procedures. This product may be employed in hot or cold water.

Eating and drinking utensils properly washed and submerged in product solutions, prepared as directed, will be sanitized in accordance with health department requirements.

Basic measurements: 4 tbsps. or 2 ozs. of this sodium hypochlorite solution added to four gallons of water equals 200 ppm available chlorine solution. 8 ozs. equals one cup or one-half pint.

**NOTE:** This product degrades with age. Use a chlorine test kit and increase dosage as necessary to obtain the required level of available chlorine.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Store in cool, dry area away from direct sunlight in case of spill. Flood area with large quantities of water. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and either return to manufacturer or discard by placing in trash collector or burying in approved landfill. Product or residue that cannot be used should be diluted with water and disposed of in a sanitary sewer. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.
