To protect from decay, mildew, termites. and powder post beetles treat wood as follows

For wood above ground with low decay exposure, such as exterior siding with a roof overhang, dilute one part of Delta C-10 with nineteen parts of water and apply using two brush coats, a spray, or a three minute dip.

For wood above ground with moderate to high decay exposure, such as fencing pickets or v. Joden shakes, dilute one part of Delta C-10 with nine parts of water and apply using two brush coats, a spray, or a three minute dip.
