### DIRECTIONS

To protect from decay, mildew, termites, and powder post beetles treat wood as follows.

For wood above ground with low decay exposure, such as exterior siding with a roof overhang, apply using two brush coats, a spray, or a three minute dip.

For wood above ground with moderate to high decay exposure, such as fencing pickets or wooden shakes, apply using two brush coats, or a spray, or a three minute dip.

For wood in ground contact exposures, such as fence posts, apply by soaking for 24 hours or longer, by hot-cold bath, or by vacuum processes.

Green or dry wood may be treated. Pigments or dyes may be added to the treating solution to provide a desired appearance to treated surfaces.

Treat wood outdoors and use treated wood only for exterior applications. Do not use treated wood where there may be extended periods of skin contact or contact with food or feed.
