ULTRACIDE is an odorless, non-evaporating, non-staining, non-flammable powder. It is a violation of FEDERAL LAW to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: SHAKE WELL BEFORE OPENING. Apply powder with a teaspoon scattering liberally under and behind refrigerator, range, dishwasher, washing machine, and dryer. Remove all lower cabinet drawers of kitchen, baths and closets and scatter liberally in drawer wells. Spread 1/2 teaspoonful in each corner of shelves on top of shelf paper in kitchen, baths, and closets. Place powder in cracks under sinks and other inaccessible areas using ALL the powder in the container. Any powder visible after application should be brushed into cracks and crevices or removed. One pound covers up to a 8 room residence plus 1 pound for basement and garage.

DIRECTIONS FOR APPLICATION WITHIN FOOD AREAS AND NON-FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS:

FOOD AREAS: APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY. Includes areas for vegetable storage, picking, canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing, preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (tollies, driers, edible oils, syrups). Serving areas (when food is exposed and ready to be consumed) also would be considered a food area.

NON-FOOD AREAS: Includes garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers, entries and vestibules), offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling). Apply to baseboard areas around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto surfaces which are exposed or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

DIRECTIONS FOR APPLYING DURING BUILDING CONSTRUCTION: Apply powder with a power or hand-operated duster to insure penetration into hidden areas among open voids. Use approximately 2 to 3 pounds per 500 square feet.
