Dear Ms. Ball:

The proposed amendment to the registration for the product cited above under The Federal Insecticide, Fungicide And Rodenticide Act, as amended revising the label in response to the DEET RED is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

1) Change the ingredients statement to read:

ACTIVE INGREDIENT
DEET.....98.11%
Other INGREDIENTS..... 1.89%

2) Change the signal word, CAUTION, to WARNING.

3) Change the Precautionary Statements to read as follows:

⌘ Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet.⌘

4) Change the First Aid section to read:

IF IN EYES:

- * Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.
- * Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first five minutes, then continue rinsing.
- * Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED:

- * Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.
- * Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
- * Do not induce vomiting unless told to by a poison control center or a doctor.
- * Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF YOU SUSPECT A REACTION TO THIS PRODUCT:

- * Discontinue use.
- * Take off contaminated clothing.
- * Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.
- * Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

5) Change the Storage And Disposal section to read:

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

IF EMPTY: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

IF PARTLY FILLED: Call your local solid waste agency (or toll free number which meets the criteria in paragraph II.E of PR Notice 2001-6) for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

6) The statement, **READ AND FOLLOW ALL DIRECTIONS AND PRECAUTIONS ON THIS PRODUCT LABEL.**, must be written in all capital letters.

7) The following statements must be grouped together in the Directions for Use section under the Subheading, General Precautions and Restrictions.

- ❖ Do not apply near eyes and mouth.❖
- ❖ Apply sparingly around ears.❖
- ❖ Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin.❖
- ❖ Do not allow children to handle this product.❖
- ❖ Do not apply to children's hands.❖
- ❖ When using on children, apply to your own hands, and then put it on the child.❖
- ❖ Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing.❖
- ❖ Do not use under clothing.❖
- ❖ Avoid over-application of this product.❖
- ❖ After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water.❖
- ❖ Do not spray in enclosed areas.❖
- ❖ If used on the face, spray on hands first and then apply sparingly and avoid eyes. Do not spray directly onto face.❖

This product is not being re-registered at this time. Product specific efficacy data will be required. Once the efficacy guidelines are in place, you will be notified of the efficacy requirements.

Also, to be eligible for re-registration, the product must be packaged in containers utilizing a concave trigger to help aim the product or other comparable mechanism that will ensure that the product will not be inadvertently sprayed in the eyes.

A stamped copy of the draft label is enclosed for your records. Submit two copies of the finished label revised in accordance with the comments listed above before the product is released for shipment under this amended label.

The Confidential Statement Of Formula (CSF) dated October 17, 2002 is acceptable and has been made a part of the file for this product.

Product specific efficacy data will be required. Once the efficacy guidelines are in place, you will be notified of the efficacy requirements.
