- d. Since this product formulation is Toxicity Category 4, you do not need the statement, "Precautionary Statements-Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals".
- e. Amend First Aid statements per PR Notice 2001-1. Because this is a toxicity category 4 product you may use the category 3 language. IF ON SKIN: Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To be used for treatment of clothing and bed nets only. Make all applications outdoors.

BITE ARMOR KIT COMPONENTS: Zip Lock Treatment Bag, 6 oz bottle of Permethrin solution, Water Proof Gloves. One Kit will adequately treat 1 adult shirt; 1 adult trousers; 1 bed net.

When clothing is properly treated according to direction, BITE ARMOR INSECT REPELLENT CLOTHING TREATMENT will protect against bites from mosquitoes, ticks, chiggers, and human body lice

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING: Application Procedure: Pour the entire contents of the bottle into the zip lock treatment bag provided with the kit. Place rolled up garment such as shirt or trousers or bed net into the bag and seal the zip lock closure. Shake bag to provide uniform coverage of garment. Let stand 2 hours or more. Wearing the water proof gloves provided with kit, unzip bag, remove garment and hang outdoors until dry (approximately 2-3 hours). When dry, garment is ready to wear. Follow standard laundering procedures. Clothing should be retreated after four weeks or after the sixth laundering to maintain adequate protection. Do Not Retreat clothing more than once every two weeks. Launder clothing at least once before retreating. For protection against Ticks (including those which may carry Lyme disease, chiggers, and mosquitoes, apply product as directed. For further protection, use in conjunction with an insect repellent registered for direct application to the skin and utilize the following primary preventive measures. Avoid areas where pests are found, wear appropriate clothing (light-colored, long sleeved shirt and long pants tucked into socks) and inspect body daily for ticks. Pant cuffs should be worn inside socks or footwear to ensure full protection against ticks and chiggers. Do Not Apply to clothing while it is being worn

CAUTION: DO NOT TREAT UNDERWEAR, HATS, CAPS, OR INNER CLOTHING. Under no circumstances should the skin or clothing on the body be treated. Wash thoroughly after handling liquid container or wet treated articles and before eating or smoking. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not use on humans. Do not allow children or pets to contact wet treated clothing until dry. Do not use indoors. Users should wear water proof gloves provided with kit during application to reduce exposure.
