STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate use of gastric lavage.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. It is compatible with most chemicals used in pool and outdoor spa and hot tub water and will not damage tile, concrete, metal or plastic. It keeps pool and outdoor spa and hot tub water free and sparkling clear of visible algae, slime and green brown colors. It improves filter operations and cuts down need for other chemicals. It imparts tone and a pleasant feel to swimming pool water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL: To control nonattached green and blue-green algae. Apply to water along pool edges after cleaning the pool. Outdoor spas and hot tubs containing heavy growths of algae should be cleaned prior to treatment. Best results are obtained with a pH of 7.2 to 7.6 and with circulating devices operating. Allow adequate time for thorough mixing before reentering the pool or outdoor spa or hot tub (at least 15 minutes). Follow directions without fail, even when pool or outdoor spa or hot tub is not used. Algae growth must be fought at all times.

SWIMMING POOLS

INITIAL DOSAGE: To a cleaned pool, add 1/2 gallon to 50,000 gallons of water or ratio thereof. If pool shows visible algae growth, double the dosage.

MAINTENANCE DOSE: Use one pint per 50,000 gallons of water every 7 to 10 days.

OUTDOOR SPAS AND HOT TUBS

INITIAL DOSAGE: To a freshly cleaned and filled outdoor spa or hot tub, add 5 to 6 fluid ounces per 1,000 gallons of water or ratio thereof. If outdoor spa or hot tub shows visible algae growth, double the dosage.

MAINTENANCE DOSE: Add 3 to 4 fluid ounces per 1,000 gallons water or ratio thereof every 5 to 7 days.

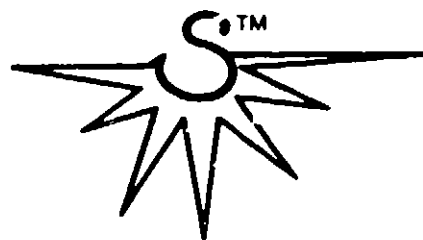

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
General Classification

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: After using the whirlpool unit, drain the water and refill with fresh water to just cover the intake valve. Add 1 ounce of **SUNSHINE'S DISINFECTANT** for each gallon of water in the unit at this point. Briefly start the pump to circulate the solution. Turn off pump. Wash down the unit sides, seat of the chairlift and any/all related equipment with a clean swab or sponge. After the unit has been thoroughly cleaned, drain solution from the unit and rinse any/all cleaned surfaces with fresh water. The unit is ready for re-use. Product to surface contact time must be at least 10 minutes for proper disinfection.
