DIRECTIONS FOR USE: After using the whirlpool unit, drain the water and refill with fresh water to just cover the intake valve. Add 1 ounce of SUNSHINE'S DISINFECTANT for each gallon of water in the unit at this point. Briefly start the pump to circulate the solution. Turn off pump. Wash down the unit sides, seat of the chairlift and any/all related equipment with a clean swab or sponge. After the unit has been thoroughly cleaned, drain solution from the unit and rinse any/all cleaned surfaces with fresh water. The unit is ready for re-use. Product to surface contact time must be at least 10 minutes for proper disinfection.
