STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and flush eyes with with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention. **IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **IF ON SKIN:** Wash with plenty of soap and water. Call a physician if irritation occurs. **IF INHALED:** Move to fresh air. Administer CPR if not breathing.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Not for use on agricultural establishments in hopper-box, planter-box, slurry-box or other seed-treatment applications at or immediately before planting.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty containers.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry location. Do not store in direct, hot sunlight.

For protection from seedling diseases caused by *Aphanomyces spp* and *Pythium spp* in Sugar Beets. Apply as a commercial seed treatment on pelleted sugar beet seeds at the rate of 45 to 90 grams of TACHIGAREN 70 WP per unit of 100,000 seeds (approx. 1 kilogram of raw sugar beet seeds).

Seed must be pelleted at a minimum weight to weight ratio of 2:1 pelleting mixture to raw seed.

Use of rates greater than 45 grams TACHIGAREN 70 WP per unit of seed may result in phytotoxicity. Use of rates greater than 45 grams are not recommended except under conditions of, or in fields with a known history of heavy disease pressure.

NOTE: Federal Law requires that bags containing treated seeds shall be labeled with the following information. "This seed has been treated with Hymexazol fungicide.
