MIXING AND LOADING: When mixing, loading, or transferring, wear protective clothing and gloves. Wash nondisposable gloves thoroughly with soap and water. The mixing and loading of spray mixtures should be done on an impervious pad (i.e., concrete slab, plastic material). If spills occur, contain the spill by using synthetic absorbent. Dispose of the contents in a plastic bag and following disposal instructions. Triple rinse empty containers and add the rinsate to the spray mixture.

CLEANING OF EQUIPMENT: When cleaning equipment, spray or drain over a large area away from buildings. This product may be applied at any time of year. Results are obtained after vegetation has emerged. For sprayers, compressed air hand sprayers, or other equipment, cleaning is required.

To control most weeds on non-cropland areas, such as roadsides and storage yards, spray at the rate of 1.5 to 2.0 gallons per acre. This product produces rapid top kill of all succulent vegetation. Non-selective herbicides produce extensive root kill of all vegetation.

This product is a liquid, non-selective, persistent herbicide. For control of all vegetation is desired. It is recommended for use in rows, parking lots, around buildings, load pipelines, industrial plant sites and other areas where drainage, create a fire hazard or cause other damage. This liquid weed killer is composed of 5-bromo-2,4-dichlorophenoxyacetic acid ester in a phytotoxic oil. Its volatility with rapid penetration and translocation in water assures full effect regardless of weather conditions at the time of application.

Do not apply this liquid to areas where the product will come into contact with driveways, walks or similar areas. Avoid spray on cotton, beans, peas, etc. Do not apply to plants and keep from contact with fertilizers, insecticides, and other products. This product may injure susceptible plants in the area of application.

Thoroughly clean all traces of product from equipment. Use a suitable chemical cleaner, then wash thoroughly to prevent water sources by cleaning of equipment.
