PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Statement of Practical Treatment

IF SWALLOWED: Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites or gelatin solution; or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a Physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: There is no specific antidote; if ingested, do not induce emesis and take care to avoid aspiration of stomach contents during gastric lavage. Give a saline laxative and supportive therapy.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes and get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not apply directly to any body of water. Do not contaminate water used for irrigation or domestic purposes by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat, sparks or open flame.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, FOOD, OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL.
