**Hand Sanitizing** - In food handling and meat cutting operations: Rinse hands and immerse in 1 oz. of this sanitizer per 5 gallons of water solution (25 ppm titratable iodine).

**Retort Cooling Water** - For canning operations - add 1 oz. of this sanitizer per 5-10 gallons of retort water prior to starting up operation to control slime and odor causing bacteria.

**Poultry Drinking Water Sanitization** - 1 oz. of this sanitizer per 10 gallons of drinking water.

**Shoe Bath Sanitizer** - To prevent tracking harmful organisms into animal areas, scrape shoes and place in a 3 oz. per gallon solution of this sanitizer for 30 seconds prior to entering area.

#### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution; or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
