

This disinfectant is an effective anti-bacterial cleaner designed for use in household, industrial and institutional cleaning. When used as directed, this product will disinfect hard surfaces, such as floors, walls, counter tops and furniture. It may be relied upon to deodorize bathroom areas, garbage pails, food storage areas, kennel areas and other areas where obnoxious odors may develop. This product may be used as a general purpose anti-bacterial-anti-fungal detergent in homes, schools, restaurants, hospitals, nursing homes, public rooms, food processing plants and in other places where efficient cleaning and anti-microbial action is desired.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IN EYES Flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician.

ON SKIN Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

SWALLOWED Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR CLEANING: *Lightly soiled areas* — surfaces to be cleaned should be mopped or brushed with a solution containing 1 ounce of this disinfectant per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned area with fresh water.

Heavily soiled areas — mop or brush soiled surface with a solution containing 2 to 3 ounces of this disinfectant per gallon of water. Rinse surface with fresh water.

GENERAL PURPOSE DISINFECTION: To disinfect walls, floors, hard non-porous surfaces in homes, schools, restaurants, and other public areas, mop or brush with a fresh solution of this disinfectant per gallon of water so as to maintain a wet surface for ten minutes. All soiled surfaces must be pre-cleaned (follow directions for cleaning). Those surfaces that later come in contact with food must be rinsed with clear water. Do not reuse used solution.

To disinfect hard non-porous surfaces in locker room, shower, walkways around pools and other areas against pathogen, brush with a fresh solution containing 1/4 ounce of this disinfectant per gallon of water so as to maintain thoroughly wetted surfaces for ten minutes. This solution will destroy *Trichophyton mentagrophytes*, the causative agent of athlete's foot. All soiled surfaces must be pre-cleaned prior to disinfection (follow directions for cleaning). Do not reuse solution.

To disinfect toilet bowls, flush toilet then force the bow trap. Add directly to bowl water 2 ounces of this disinfectant. Scrub all surfaces thoroughly including under the rim, and allow to sit for at least ten minutes before flushing toilet.

HOSPITAL DISINFECTION: To disinfect walls, floors, furniture, hard non-porous surfaces in hospitals and nursing homes, mop or brush with a fresh solution containing 2 ounces of this disinfectant per gallon of water so as to maintain thoroughly wetted surface for ten minutes.
