

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Ram Poly - Algaecide is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and indoor effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and hot tubs. A heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using Ram Poly - Algaecide.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of Ram Poly - Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. For treatment of pools with settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of pools with heavy growth of algae add initially 12.8 to 23.5 fluid ounces of Ram Poly - Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of Ram Poly - Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, or decorative fountains should be treated with Ram Poly - Algaecide per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly installed hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 1 fluid ounce of Ram Poly - Algaecide per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of Ram Poly - Algaecide per 1,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment. Ram Poly - Algaecide is compatible with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of chlorine required. However, do not mix Ram Poly - Algaecide with liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and disposed of with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Dispose of contents and container as directed.
