CAUTION

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Promptly drink a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

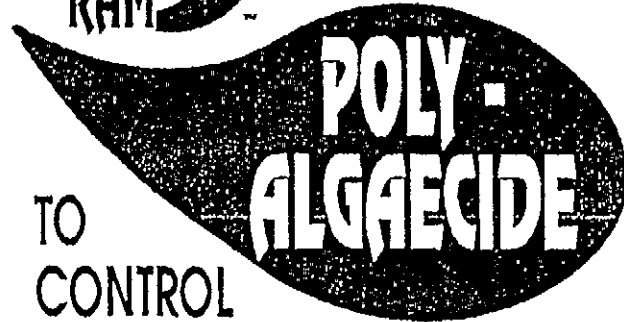
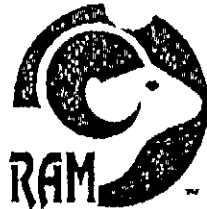
If in Eyes: Flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes. Consult a physician if irritation occurs.

In Case Of Skin Contact: Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Get medical attention if irritation occurs, promptly.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. Mop up spills with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and stored away from food. DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and place in trash.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

INITIAL APPLICATION FOR SWIMMING POOLS

RAM POLY-ALGAECIDE is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds that do not contain fish. For maximum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using RAM POLY-ALGAECIDE.

For pools having just visible algae growth add one pound of shock (calcium hypochlorite) and an initial dose of 24 to 36 fluid ounces of RAM POLY-ALGAECIDE per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae. For treatment of freshly cleaned and filled pools add 13 to 24 fluid ounces of RAM POLY-ALGAECIDE per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 4 to 9 fluid ounces of RAM POLY-ALGAECIDE per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains and ponds having just visible algae growth require and additional dose of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of RAM POLY-ALGAECIDE per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 4 to 9 fluid ounces of RAM POLY-ALGAECIDE should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

RAM POLY-ALGAECIDE will prevent growth of most algae during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. For pools which have been properly treated during the swimming season and are free of visible algae, add 13 to 21 fluid ounces of algacide per 10,000 gallons of water. If at the end of swimming season pools have some visible algae growth, add 25 to 37 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of algacide throughout the water and the pool be made for maximum effectiveness. If pool is not covered, it may be necessary to repeat the treatment one to three times during the season.

RAM POLY-ALGAECIDE is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective on both acid and alkaline pH. RAM POLY-ALGAECIDE can be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix RAM POLY-ALGAECIDE with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.
