

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. RAM SPA ALGAECIDE is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, that do not contain fish. For maximum effectiveness in decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth to using RAM SPA ALGAECIDE.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial fluid ounces of RAM SPA ALGAECIDE to remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of algae add initially 41 to 75 fluid ounces of RAM SPA ALGAECIDE per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 RAM SPA ALGAECIDE per 10,000 gallons of water every 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds with visible algae growth require an initial dose of 8 RAM SPA ALGAECIDE per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 RAM SPA ALGAECIDE per 1000 gallons of water should be made for maintenance.

RAM SPA ALGAECIDE will provide protection during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. Pools only treated during the swimming season and are free of algae should add 65 fluid ounces of algicide per 10,000 gallons of water. Season pools have some visible algae growth, add 7 fluid ounces of RAM SPA ALGAECIDE per 10,000 gallons. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of water and the pool be made for maximum effectiveness. It may be necessary to repeat the treatment one or more times.

RAM SPA ALGAECIDE is compatible with chlorine products. RAM SPA ALGAECIDE is compatible with chlorine products. RAM SPA ALGAECIDE can be used with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of chlorine required. However, do not mix RAM SPA ALGAECIDE with chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. Keep container closed when not in use. Labeling should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children.
