

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling.

RAM Mustard Out™ is used to control the growth of mustard algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using RAM Mustard-Out™.

For pools having just visible mustard algae growth (yellowish coloring clinging on walls) follow these directions:

- 1.) Turn pool system on
- 2.) After sundown super chlorinate — 1 lb. RAM Shock™ per 10,000 gallons — broadcast in pool.
- 3.) Adjust PH to 7.4-7.6.
- 4.) Brush walls thoroughly.
- 5.) Add 32 oz. (one qt.) of RAM Mustard Out™ per 10,000 gallons — pour along all walls.
- 6.) Next Day — add 8 oz. per 10,000 gallons of RAM Water Clarifier.
- 7.) To prevent reoccurrence add 4 oz. per 10,000 gallons of RAM Mustard Out™ per 10,000 gallons — after 30 days maintenance dosage may be reduced to 2 oz. per 10,000 gallons weekly.

This product will not eat up chlorine and need not be followed up with chlorine. It is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas. RAM Mustard Out™ can be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix RAM Mustard Out™ with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.
