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

This product may be used to formulate products for specific use(s) not listed on this label if the formulator, user group or grower has complied with U.S. EPA data submission requirements regarding the support of such use(s).

This product may be used only to formulate pesticide products if the labeling contains the following information and/or use directions. All products manufactured for residential and turf (excluding sod farms) must contain the label language below. All other products (i.e., agricultural, aquatic and industrial) must bear the label language below.

General Requirements for End-Use Product Labeling

- 1. Containers over 1 gallon and less than 5 gallons in capacity must bear the following statement: Persons engaged in open pouring of this product must also wear coveralls or a chemical resistant apron.
- 2. Containers of 5 gallons or more in capacity must also bear the following statement: A mechanical system (probe and pump) must be used for transferring the contents of this container. If the contents of a non-refillable pesticide container are emptied, the probe must be rinsed before removal.

Specific Requirements for End-Use Product Labeling

Agricultural Uses

- 1. Clothing requirement statements: When mixing, loading or applying this product or repairing or cleaning equipment used with this product, wear eye protection (face shield or safety glasses), chemical resistant gloves, long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks and shoes. It is recommended that safety glasses include front, brow and temple protection. For aerial applicators in an enclosed cockpit and applicators applying this product from a tractor that has a completely enclosed cab, eye protection is not required.
- 2. Personal hygiene statements: Wash hands, face and arms with soap and water as soon as possible after mixing, loading or applying this product. Wash hands, face and arms with soap and water before eating, smoking or drinking. Wash hands and arms before using toilet. After work, remove all clothing and shower using soap and water. Do not reuse clothing worn during the previous day's mixing and loading or application of this product without cleaning first. Clothing must be kept and washed separately from other household laundry. Remove saturated clothing as soon as possible and shower.
- 3. The maximum application rate to pasture and rangeland is the lower of:
 - a) the existing application rate on a currently registered label; or
 - b) 2 pounds 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application per site.
- 4. The maximum application rate to forestry site preparation is the lower of:

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a) the existing application rate on a currently registered label; or

b) 4 pounds 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application per site.

5. A reentry interval is required and should be in accordance with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR Parts 156 and 170.

Industrial/Aquatic Uses

1. Clothing requirement statements: When mixing, loading or applying this product or repairing or cleaning equipment used with this product, wear eye protection (face shield or safety glasses), chemical resistant gloves, long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks and shoes. It is recommended that safety glasses include front, brow and temple protection. For aerial applicators in an enclosed cockpit and applicators applying this product from a tractor that has a completely enclosed cab, eye protection is not required.

2. Personal hygiene statements: Wash hands, face and arms with soap and water as soon as possible after mixing, loading or applying this product. - c) Products registered for use on residential and other turf sites (excluding sod farms) by homeowners and other non-commercial users, and for commercial mixer/loader/applicators when the product is to be applied to a golf course, amine products applied in liquid form and bearing a "WARNING" or "DANGER" signal word must bear only the following language: When using this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes, rubber gloves and eye protection. It is recommended that safety glasses include front, brow and temple protection.
- d) Products registered for use on residential and other turf sites (excluding sod farms) by homeowners and other non-commercial users, and for commercial mixer/loader/applicators when the product is to be applied to a golf course, acid, sodium salt and ester products applied in liquid form and bearing a "CAUTION" signal word must bear only the following language: When using this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes and chemical-resistant gloves.
- e) Products registered for use on residential and other turf sites (excluding sod farms) by homeowners and other non-commercial users, and for commercial mixer/loader/applicators when the product is to be applied to a golf course, acid sodium salt and ester products applied in liquid form and bearing a "WARNING" or "DANGER" signal word must bear only the following language: When using this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes and chemical-resistant gloves and eye protection. It is recommended that safety glasses include front, brow and temple protection.
- f) Products registered for use on residential and other turf sites (excluding sod farms) by commercial mixer/loader/applicators (except when the product is to be applied to a golf course) applied in liquid form and bearing a "CAUTION" signal word must bear only the following language: When mixing, loading or applying this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes and chemical-resistant gloves.
- g) Products registered for use on residential and other turf sites (excluding sod farms) by commercial mixer/loader/applicators (except when the product is to be applied to a golf course) applied in liquid form and bearing a "WARNING" or "DANGER" signal word must bear only the following language: When mixing, loading or applying this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes, chemical-resistant gloves and eye protection. It is recommended that safety glasses include front, brow and temple protection.

2. Personal hygiene statements:

- a) for all granular products: After using this product, remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water.
- b) for all liquid products: After using this product, rinse gloves before removing, remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water. Remove saturated clothing as soon as possible and shower.
- The maximum application rate to turf is the lower of:
 - a) the existing application rate on a currently registered label; or
 - b) 2 pounds 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application per site.

The maximum number of broadcast applications per treatment site is 2 per year.

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4. The following reentry statement must be included: Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treatment areas until spray has dried or dust has settled.
