

CRYSTALENE 18 - 1st Treatment is used to control the growth of signe In swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness pools, spas, whicloools, and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using <u>CRYSTALENE 18 - 1st Treatment</u> For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 23.5 to 36.4. fluid ounces of <u>CRYSTALENE 18 - 1st Tre</u> per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool add initially 12.8 to 23.5 fluid ounces of CRYSTALENE 18 - 1st Teatmet per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 4.3 to 8.6 fluid ounces of <u>CRYSTALENE 18 - 1 st</u> per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance. Spas, whirlpools, or hot tubs having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of <u>CRYSTALENE 18 - 1st Trper 1000 gallons</u> of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled spa, whirlpool, or hot tub, add ini-1 to 2 fluid ounces of <u>CRYSTALENE 18 - 1st Treat</u> per 1,000 gallons of water.
