For maximum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using CRYSTALENE 12 — 1st Treatment 56.5 to 56 fluid ounces of CRYSTALENE 12 — 1st Tr per 10,000 galions of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool add initially 20 to 36.5 fluid ounces of CRYSTALENE 12 — 1st Tr per 10,000 galions of water.
