GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with
its labeling.

CRYSTALENE 30 - Booster is used to control the growth of algae
in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness
pools, spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned
prior to using CRYSTALENE 30 - Booster

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 30 to 46
fluid ounces of CRYSTALENE 30 - Booster per 10,000 gallons of water and re-
move settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled
pool add initially 16.4 to 30 fluid ounces of CRYSTALENE 30 - Booster
per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 5.5 to 10.9 fluid ounces
of CRYSTALENE 30 - Booster per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to
7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, or hot tubs having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of
2.7 to 5.5 fluid ounces of CRYSTALENE 30 - Booster per 1000 gallons
of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled spa, whirlpool, or hot tub, add ini-
tially 1.6 to 3.0 fluid ounces of CRYSTALENE 30 - Booster per
1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.5 to 1.1 fluid ounces of
CRYSTALENE 30 - Booster should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treat-
ment for maintenance.

CRYSTALENE 30 - Booster is compatible with those chemicals normally
used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH.
CRYSTALENE 30 - Booster can be used in pools and spas treated with
chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required.
However, do not mix CRYSTALENE 30 - Booster with concentrated dry or
liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Keep container closed when not in use. Do not
contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.
Rinsate that cannot be used or reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill ap-
proved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies. Open
dumping is prohibited.

- METAL CONTAINERS: Triple
rinse and offer for recycling,
reconditioning, or disposal in an
approved landfill or bury in a safe
place.
- PLASTIC CONTAINERS: Do not
reuse empty container. Triple rinse
and incinerate or dispose of in an
approved landfill or bury in safe
place.
