DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply Formulation I-1.75 with a cloth, mop or mechanical spray device. When applied with a mechanical spray device, surface must be sprayed until thoroughly wetted. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty. Formulation I-1.75 is a proven "one-step" cleaner-disinfectant-sanitizer-deodorizer in the presence of moderate amounts of organic soil and 400 ppm hard water.

Disinfectant—Hospitals, Veterinary Clinics, Other Health Care Institutions, Institutions, Industry, Schools, Farm Premises and Poultry Hoouses:

Apply 1/2 oz. per gallon Formulation I-1.75 to walls, floors and other hard (nonporous) nonporous surfaces such as tables, chairs, countertops, tile, porcelain, sinks and bedframes. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required.

Sanitizer—Meat and food processing equipment and utensils: Remove heavy soils by flushing, scraping, or mopping. Wash with 1 oz. per gallon of Formulation I-1.75 (or other good cleaner). Rinse with clean water and sanitize surfaces with 1 oz. Formulation I-1.75 per 5 gallons of water (25 ppm titratable iodine). Surface should remain in contact with solution for 1-2 minutes. Drain well and air dry. No potable water rinse is required.
