- b. Remove "Lethal Weapon", from the name of your product. It is the Agency's view that terms, such as "Lethal Weapon", are misleading health and safety claims and therefore constitute misbranding under section 2(Q)(1)(A) of FIFRA. Therefore, the use of "Lethal Weapon" and other similar claims is not permitted for any product registered under FIFRA.
  - c. Revise the Precautionary Statements Statement to Read:

Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid breathing dust. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing.

- Apply a line from corner in rear of kitchen cabinets or drill H holes at top of kick panels beneath cabinets in kitchen and bathrooms, dusting liberally.
- Remove lower drawers in the kitchens and bathroom cabinets, bedroom dressers, and chest of drawers and liberally dust into drawers and liberally dust into wells and under bookshelves.

2. A one year Storage Stability (830.6317) and Corrosion Characteristics, (830.6320) studies are a requirement for the formulated product. You are required to generate a one year storage stability study for the proposed product under warehouse conditions. It is recommended that observations are made at 0,3,6,9, and 12 months intervals. The corrosion characteristics study may be carried out concurrently. These studies must be provided to the Agency within 18 months from the date of initial registration for this product.
