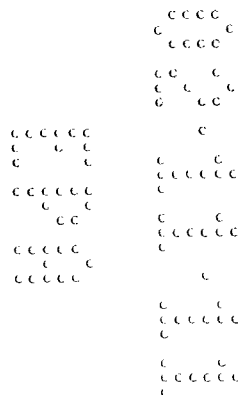

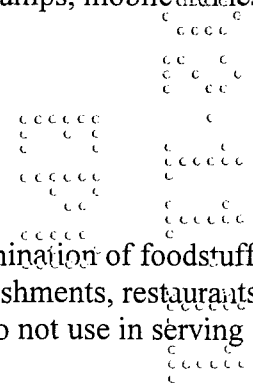
It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product may be used in homes, restaurants, markets, schools, warehouses, factories, offices, hotels, motels, hospitals, nursing homes, garages, grocery stores, apartment buildings, new construction, industrial plants, theaters, ships, boats, trains, trucks, yachts, camps, mobile homes, buses, zoos, kennels, military bases, libraries, utilities, and sewers.

RESIDENTIAL USE

Use Restrictions:

-Apply only in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Avoid contamination of foodstuff and feed. Do not use in edible product areas of food handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.



Application Directions

1. Using easy applicator, create a barrier through which cockroaches and other insects must crawl.
2. Apply under and behind refrigerator, stove, sink, dishwasher, washing machine, dryer, and tubs in kitchen and utility rooms.
3. Apply in cracks and crevices along baseboards and corners of cabinets, cupboards, and closets.
4. Apply a line from corner to corner in rear of kitchen cabinets or drill 1/2" holes at top of kick panels beneath cabinets in kitchen and bathrooms, by dusting sparingly.
5. Remove lower drawers in the kitchens and bathroom cabinets, bedroom dressers, and chest of drawers and dust into drawer wells and under bookshelves.
6. Apply into openings and void areas around plumbing, drains, pipes, and electrical conduits.
7. Any powder visible after application may be brushed into cracks and crevices or removed. Reapply after 30 days if necessary.

Bed Bugs

Apply this product in cracks and crevices or spots where evidence of bed bugs occur. This includes bed frames, box springs, inside empty drawers and clothes closets, night stands and other non-upholstered furniture in the room, floor moldings, window casings, wall voids, behind wall hangings, wallpaper edges, and popcorn ceilings. Take bed apart. Treat joints and channels if hollow, such as square or round tubing, and see that interior framework is treated. Bed bugs may also harbor in areas of the room away from the bed. Reapply weekly if necessary. Do not use this product on mattresses, pillows, bed linens, clothes, carpets, or upholstery. No recommended for use as sole protection against bed bugs. If evidence of bed bugs is found in/on mattresses, carpet or on upholstery, use products approved for these uses. Allow all treated areas to dry thoroughly before use.

COMMERCIAL USE (Nonedible Product Areas Only)

Application in new and existing construction to control cockroaches and other insects.

Wear normal work clothing (e.g., long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes plus socks) and a NIOSH/MSHA approved dust mask respirator.

1. When treating large areas, such as voids, soffit, and subcabinet voids, dust liberally.
2. Dust into pits of dumbwaiters, elevator shafts, and trash chutes.
3. In storerooms, dust under pallets and behind boxes.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store product in original container away from food and feedstuffs. Keep product in a locked storage area. Store in a dry place where children and animals cannot gain access.

Container Disposal: If empty: Non refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down an indoor or outdoor drain.
