

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Harmful To Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin. Wash hands after using. Avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact flush with plenty of water. Avoid breathing the spray mist. Keep children and domestic animals off treated areas until this material has been washed into the soil.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not feed treated forage to livestock or grass treated areas. Do not spray or allow drift onto vegetables, ornamentals or other desirable plants. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from target area. Do not spray directly to water.

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL INFORMATION: This product is recommended for selective "Post Emergent" weed control in Lawns and Ornamental Turf and Non-Crop areas as listed. Apply When temperatures are warm (70° F+) and weeds are actively growing.

MIXING: Fill the spray tank 1/2 full and then thoroughly dissolve this product into the spray solution, then fill tank to proper level. Do not store solution in tank over night. Clean application equipment after using by flushing with water. (See "Storage & Disposal" Statement).

HOW TO APPLY: Use a hand pump sprayer, a garden type pressure sprayer, or sprinkler can. Do not use a sprayer that is used for the application of insecticides or fungicides due to possible contamination. Thoroughly wet all target weeds. Avoid wetting desirable turf grass where possible. A fan type nozzle will give best results. Apply on a calm day to avoid spray drift to susceptible plants.

GENERAL INFORMATION

LAWN RENOVATOR Herbicide is a solution of cacodylic acid and sodium cacodylate. It is a non-selective herbicide. LAWN RENOVATOR will kill grasses and weeds on contact. Destruction of weeds and grasses around plants, shrubs, trees and bushes may be accomplished by directing spray to the undesired vegetation.

NOTE: Heavy turf or woody weeds (generally perennials) may require a higher concentration, particularly if they have a heavy root system. The amount of treatment needed will decrease as temperature increases. Only marginal effectiveness can be expected in cold weather.

Plants will die in one to three days (depending on species) when LAWN RENOVATOR is applied, in hot, sunny days. Three to five days after application during cool temperatures. For best results, wet foliage thoroughly. Matted turf or weed areas may require further applications about 10-14 days apart. Bermuda grass and other perennial grasses and weeds may survive some applications. See regrowth from roots.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

NOTE-CROP: LAWN RENOVATOR is useful for general weed control on drainage ditches and rights-of-way along sidewalks, driveways and fences, around buildings and ornamentals, and on similar non-crop areas. Mix 1 to 2 gallons of LAWN RENOVATOR in 100 gallons of water. Spray unwanted vegetation to just short of run-off. If regrowth occurs reapply as required.

Do not allow spray to come in contact with foliage, green bark, grafted unions, or scuffed, damaged or broken bark when spraying around trees and ornamentals.

DIRECTION FOR USE:

LAWN RENOVATOR for lawn renovation. To destroy weeds sections of lawn and turf, apply LAWN RENOVATOR at any time during the warm growing season. Sun and high temperature accelerate desiccation. Foliage should be wet thoroughly to run-off using the spray solution at the following rates:

Rate	Amount of Water	Acre Covered
1 quart	12-15 gallons	1,500 sq. ft.
1 gallon	50-60 gallons	14,000 sq. ft.

To prepare spray solution fill spray tank with the desired quantity of water. While agitating, add the required amount of LAWN RENOVATOR. Thoroughly mix prior to application. LAWN RENOVATOR contains a suitable surfactant. NO OTHER WETTING AGENT NEED BE ADDED TO THE SPRAY SOLUTION. The spray should be carefully calibrated for best results and the spray solution applied at the proper rate in the proper amount of water to the properly measured area.

LAWN RENOVATOR will top-kill perennials. Repeat application may be necessary. Apply second treatment 5 days after first application. LAWN RENOVATOR Herbicide may be used in non-crop areas, along rights-of-way, and in drainage ditches. Do not use in vegetable patches. Do not cause contamination.

Clean equipment after use by flushing with water. Run three water in each empty tank to water sources.

USE IN ACCORDANCE WITH DIRECTIONS, WARNING AND CAUTION

Re-seeding after weed control should be preceded by heavy watering. Consult agriculture experimental station and extension service weed specialists for most desirable seeds and mixtures. Seeds may be worked into soil if necessary, by scarifying or raking. A light top dressing of screened peat moss will help retain moisture during germination. Delay re-seeding a minimum of 5 days after last application.

LAWN RENOVATOR when used as directed will economically eliminate or destroy a large variety of weeds and grasses. Highly recommended for use on RECREATIONAL AREAS including PARKS and GOLF COURSES, INDUSTRIAL SITES, ALONG DITCH BANKS and RIGHTS-OF-WAY, FENCE ROWS, WALKS and DRIVEWAYS. Safe to use around most species of plants, trees and shrubs. Controls garden ivy, brambles, briars, and stump sprouts. LAWN RENOVATOR OR NOT FOR TURFGRASS AND FINE-LEAVED GRASSES.
