DIRECTIONS FOR USE (CONT.)

BEANS

To control twelve spotted beetles, thrips, flea beetle, apply when insects appear and repeat as necessary.

CORN (Sweet)

To control European Corn Borer, apply when insects are predominately in the larvae stage. Repeat 7 - 10 day intervals.

CUCUMBERS, MELONS, SQUASH, PUMPKINS

To control striped and twelve spotted cucumber beetles. Apply when insects appear and continue applications weekly until danger of insect injury is past. Re-dust after rains and continue with regular application of 1.5% ROTENONE DUST as often as necessary.

TOMATOES

To control potato pee beetles and Colorado potato beetles and small tomato Hornworms: Begin application 2 to 3 days after plants are set in the field to control tomato worms, apply when worms are still small. Continue dusting 1.5% ROTENONE DUST as often as necessary.

POTATOES AND EGG PLANTS

To control Colorado beetles and potato flea beetles: Begin application when insects make appearance. Repeat at 5 to 7 day intervals as necessary when danger of insect injury is past. Continue regular applications of 1.5% ROTENONE DUST as often as necessary.

CABBAGE

Imported Cabbage Worms: Apply 1.5% ROTENONE DUST when worms appear. Repeat dusting as often as necessary.

ASPARAGUS

Asparagus Beetle and Spotted Asparagus Beetle. The spears should be dusted with 1.5% ROTENONE DUST and when possible apply when the insects are predominately in the larvae stage. Repeat dusting as often as necessary.

ROSE BUSHES

Slugs on Rose Bushes: Dust bushes thoroughly while wet with dew. Repeat dusting in a few days if necessary.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS
1.5% ROTENONE DUST may be applied at any time when dusting conditions are favorable (on a calm day). The dust may be applied during the daytime to either moist or dry foliage. Apply dust regularly at 7 to 10 day intervals, beginning soon after plants are above ground. For best results keep foliage evenly coated with the dust. This is especially important on new growth. Thoroughly dust upper and lower leaf surfaces.
