

**CARROTS** - **BRIDGOLI, CALLIFLOWER** - Anterior, spray weekly. Use 4 to 6 lbs. ZNEB 75% WP per acre. Apply at 7 to 14 day intervals in warm 7 days of harvest.

**PLANT BEANS** - Use 3 lbs. ZNEB 75% WP per 100 gallons water per acre. Apply at weekly intervals.

**CANY BLDWING, CUCUMBER, WATERMELON** - Anterior, spray weekly. Apply at 7 to 14 day intervals. Cover underside of leaves thoroughly. Do not apply within 5 days of harvest.

**CARROTS** - Anterior, spray weekly. Apply at 7 to 14 day intervals in warm 7 days of harvest. Do not apply to soil or leaf.

**CILANTRO** - Early and late light. Spray plant beds at 3 to 5 day intervals. Control field application weekly. Remove weeds, including at harvest by digging, pulling or burning. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest.

**COLLARD, KALE, MUSTARD, SARDIN, PARSNIP** - Anterior, spray weekly. Apply at 7 to 14 day intervals in warm 7 days of harvest.

**CORN** - Anterior, spray weekly. Apply at 7 to 14 day intervals in warm 7 days of harvest.

**CRUCIFERAE** - Anterior, spray weekly. Apply at 7 to 14 day intervals in warm 7 days of harvest.

**LETTUCE** - Anterior, spray weekly. Apply at 7 to 14 day intervals in warm 7 days of harvest.

**POTATOES** - Anterior, spray weekly. Apply at 7 to 14 day intervals in warm 7 days of harvest.

**TOMATOES** - Anterior, spray weekly. Apply at 7 to 14 day intervals in warm 7 days of harvest.

**FIELD CROPS**

**BEANS** - Anterior, spray weekly. Apply at 7 to 14 day intervals in warm 7 days of harvest.

**WHEAT** - Anterior, spray weekly. Apply at 7 to 14 day intervals in warm 7 days of harvest.

**PLANT BEANS**

**TOMATOES** - Anterior, spray weekly. Apply at 7 to 14 day intervals in warm 7 days of harvest.

**LETTUCE-PEPPER** - Damping off. Control early weekly after seedling with 1/2 gal. per sq. yd. of water containing 1 lb. ZNEB 75% WP per 50 gal. water.

**NOTE** - ZNEB 75% WP may be used without any special dilution. When necessary to control the fungus, coverage by foliage should be good and to control soil-borne disease an additional soil application is recommended.

**ORNAMENTALS**

**GENERAL DIRECTIONS** - Use ZNEB 75% WP at 1 lb. per 100 gallons of water. Apply at weekly intervals.

**AZALEA, CAMELLIA** - Damping off. Spray 2 to 3 times a week while plants are young. Do not spray when flowers are open.

**CARNATION BEGONIAS** - Fusarium wilt. Spray 2 to 3 times weekly at 3 month intervals with 1 lb. ZNEB 75% WP per 100 gallons per 100 square feet of leaf area.

**CARNATIONS, CHRISTMAS TREES, HOLLYHOCKS, IRIS, DRAGON** - Damping off. Spray 2 to 3 times weekly at 3 month intervals with 1 lb. ZNEB 75% WP per 100 gallons per 100 square feet of leaf area.

**GLADIOLUS** - Botrytis blight. Control weekly with 1 lb. ZNEB 75% WP per 100 gallons per 100 square feet of leaf area.

**ROSES** - Black spot. Apply at weekly intervals.

**TIME GRASSES** - Anthracnose. Control weekly with 1 lb. ZNEB 75% WP per 100 gallons per 100 square feet of leaf area.

**For Pythium blight on grasses** - Use 2 lbs. ZNEB 75% WP per 100 gallons per 100 square feet of leaf area. Apply at weekly intervals at 3 to 7 days when blight is first observed or every 3 to 4 days when disease is severe. Control application rate and interval should be 1 lb. ZNEB 75% WP per 100 gallons per 100 square feet of leaf area.

**NOTE** - Do not apply to soil or to plants that are stressed or injured. Do not apply to plants that are stressed or injured.
