

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**  
**HAZARD TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS**  
**CAUTION**  
 Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. Keep spray out of eyes. Wash hands thoroughly after application.

**APPLES, PEARS, PEACHES, CHERRIES, PLUMS, GRAPES:** Use ½ cupful to one gallon of water (1½ Gal. 50) to control European Red Mite eggs, certain aphids, and scale insects.

**OAKS, ELM, WILLOWS, BASSWOOD (Linden):** Use at same strength as for fruit trees. Do not use on Maples, Mountain Ash (Sorbus) and Beech.

**LILAC, ROSES, FLOWERING QUINCE, COTTON-EASTER, HAWTHORN:** Reduce dosage to one cupful in three gallons of water (1 Gal. 50).

**EVERGREENS:** Fir, Spruce, Pine, Yews, and Arborvitae are quite sensitive to oils. Blue Spruce may be discolored. Be extremely careful not to overspray. Use one cupful in three gallons of water. Do not exceed this dosage. Apply as a fine mist just before new Spring growth starts. Do not use on Broadleaf evergreens.
