

RESEDING

Any material that provides effective control of annual grasses may affect new lawn grass seedlings which germinate after treatment. Proper fertilization and watering will encourage the existing turf grass to fill in the thin or bare spots formerly occupied by crabgrass.

The following procedures are suggested in order to minimize any stunting of turf grasses which may occur when re-seeding into BETASAN 12.5G treated areas:

1 Do not reseed within 4 months after application. Resovate the area to be reseeded by raking thoroughly to scarify the soil surface. Where practical, mix peat in with the soil to provide and optimum seed bed.

2 When turf diseases or physiological diseases.

2 When turf diseases or physiological disorders necessitate reseeding somer than 4 month—after BETASAN 12 5G application, sipply powdered activated charcoal prior to resending to deactivate the BETASAN 12.5G.
