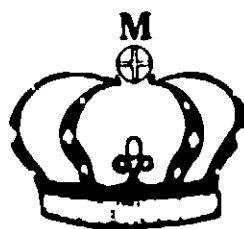

**DIRECTIONS**

THIRAM TURF FUNGICIDE should be used only in accordance with recommendations on this label.

**Turf** - THIRAM TURF FUNGICIDE used in conjunction with good turf management will usually prevent and control large brown patch and dollar spot on golf greens, grass tennis courts, lawns and other fine turfs. Make regular spray applications at intervals of 7 to 10 days \*\* beginning before the earliest probable appearance of the diseases and continuing throughout the season.

When such a preventive spray schedule is not followed, the turf should be inspected each morning and at the first appearance of brown patch or dollar spot the curative rate of THIRAM TURF FUNGICIDE should be applied. When treating golf greens, always treat aprons and approaches.

**For the Control of Snow Mold** - Use 8 oz. THIRAM TURF FUNGICIDE per 1000 sq. ft. applied as late in the Fall as possible, prior to snowfall. Follow with a Spring application of 3 ozs. per 1000 sq. ft. applied as soon as the snow melts.

**To Prepare Sprays** - Use only enough water to spray or sprinkle the area thoroughly (usually 5 to 10 gals. per 1000 sq. ft.). For high pressure sprayers, use from 200 to 300 lbs. pressure and 5 gals. of water per 1000 sq. ft. applied as a fine spray. THIRAM TURF FUNGICIDE is insoluble in water and will tend to settle out; constant agitation is necessary.

**NOTE** Do not water or mow grass after treatment until the fungicide is thoroughly dry, preferably 24 hours after application.

**Sweet Potato Sprouts** - THIRAM TURF FUNGICIDE is generally effective for control of stem rot and scurf. Dip the roots of the sprouts for 1/2 minute in a suspension made by mixing 1 lb. THIRAM TURF FUNGICIDE in 7 1/2 gals. of water. Agitate suspension frequently. Plant sprouts promptly after treatment.

**Gladiolus Bulbs** - As a storage or preplanting treatment, THIRAM TURF FUNGICIDE usually prevents basal rot and decay. Treat any time after drying. Coat bulbs well with THIRAM TURF FUNGICIDE by shaking in paper bag or similar device, or by dipping in a suspension made by mixing 1 lb. THIRAM TURF FUNGICIDE in 8 gals. of water. Agitate suspension frequently. If bulbs are to be stored, spread out to dry.

Follow State turf disease control recommendations for further details on application timing.

When conditions are unusually favorable for the development of diseases, the disease is active, reduce the interval between sprays to 5 to 7 days, and use the rate for curative treatment.
