DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply only in areas inaccessible to children and pets.

Use your thumb and forefinger to sprinkle the Roach Cake crumbs where roaches are likely to be found. Areas include kitchen cabinets, shelves and drawers, and under the sink; behind the refrigerator, the stove and the washer and dryer; and on the shelves in bedroom and bathroom closets. The inert ingredients in the Roach Cake are a combination of attractants that produces a smell, taste and cake-like texture which lure the roaches and ensure that the roaches eat it. Clearhouse Roach Cake kills roaches after they eat it. When the roaches have eaten the Roach Cake, they crawl away to die.

Reapply as necessary.

This product may be used in homes, restaurants, markets, schools, warehouses, factories, offices, hotels, motels, hospitals, nursing homes, garages, grocery stores, apartment buildings, new construction, industrial plants, theatres, ships, boats, trains, trucks, yachts, camps, mobile homes, buses, airplanes, zoos, kennels, military bases, libraries, and utilities.

The contents of this package is enough to treat a house, apartment or office. Use the entire contents of this package in one application. Once the Roach Cake has been applied it should not be removed unless and until you do a reapplication. You will notice a lessening of roach activity during the first week, but give CLEARHOUSE ROACH CAKE a full sixty days to do its job.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in paper and place in trash collection.

NOTE: For best results, keep the kitchen area clean. Do not let dirty dishes stand in the sink. Empty the garbage can regularly, even daily if you can. If possible, use a plastic bag as a liner in your garbage can for sanitary purposes. If you have a pet, keep the animal's dish clean. Repair any water leaks or drips. Roaches like dark, damp areas. If there are any cracks in a wall or around a pipe that open to the outside, or that might provide access for roaches from an adjoining apartment, seal these cracks with caulking compound.


