#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

CAL HYPO GIANT TABS are a slow dissolving form of calcium hypochlorite which provide a convenient source of available chlorine. It is recommended for use as a sewage effluent disinfectant and for other related applications where a continuous source of chlorine is required.

The amount of chlorine delivered will depend upon the flow rate of the water being treated, the amount of CAL HYPO GIANT TABS being used, and the configuration of the active bed of tablets. To provide an available chlorine concentration of 6 ppm will require about 1.4 pounds, or six CAL HYPO GIANT TABS for each 20,000 gallons of water treated. In practice the number of CAL HYPO GIANT TABS used should be adjusted to satisfy the chlorine demand and to maintain a proper chlorine residual. Measurement of the total available chlorine (combined plus free) in water treated with CAL HYPO GIANT TABS is best accomplished by employing the idometric titration technique described in Standard Methods for the Examination of Water and Wastewater, Nineteenth Edition, 1995, American Public Health Association, section 4, pp 36-53.

# STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage: Keep this product dry in a tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. Shelf life is one (1) year in an UNOPENED container.
