## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

**CAL HYPO GIANT TABS** are a slow dissolving form of calcium hypochlorite which provide a convenient source of available chlorine. It is recommended for use as a sewage effluent disinfectant and for other related applications where a continuous source of chlorine is required.

The amount of chlorine delivered will depend upon the flow rate of the water being treated, the amount of **CAL HYPO GIANT TABS** being used, and the configuration of the active bed of tablets. To provide an available chlorine concentration of 6 ppm will require about 1.4 pounds, or six **CAL HYPO GIANT TABS** for each 20,000 gallons of water treated. In practice the number of **CAL HYPO GIANT TABS** used should be adjusted to satisfy the chlorine demand and to maintain a proper chlorine residual. Measurement of the total available chlorine (combined plus free) in water treated with **CAL HYPO GIANT TABS** is best accomplished by employing the idometric titration technique described in Standard Methods for the Examination of Water and Wastewater, Nineteenth Edition, 1995, American Public Health Association, section 4, pp 36-53.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DO NOT contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**Pesticide Storage:** Keep this product dry in a tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. Shelf life is one (1) year in an UNOPENED container.
