HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DIRECTIONS FOR PREPARING POOL CHLORINATING SOLUTION: For a new pool or to regenerate an existing pool, add 1.0 liter of this product to 1000 gallons of water. This dosage is equivalent to 5 ppm available chlorine by weight.

FOR POOL MAINTENANCE: Adjust pool water pH to 7.0-7.6. If range is not within this range, adjust pH accordingly. Add 1.0 liter of this product to 1000 gallons of water. This dosage is equivalent to 5 ppm available chlorine by weight. Maintain pH to 7.0-7.6. Maintain chlorine level at 1.0 ppm. One liter of this product is equivalent to 5 ppm available chlorine by weight. Frequency of additions to maintain 0.5 to 1.0 ppm available chlorine will depend on temperature and of number swimmers.
