DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DB 17 is used in industrial and/or commercial recirculating cooling tower systems and industrial air-washing systems to control microbiological slime. Prior to the use of DB 17 in industrial and/or commercial recirculating cooling tower systems, systems should be cleaned to remove algal growth, microbiological slime, and other deposits. Then make an initial slug addition of 7.0 to 10.5 fl. oz. of DB 17 per 1000 gal. of water to provide 60 to 90 ppm of DB 17, based on total weight of water in the system. Repeat initial dosage until control is evident. Make subsequent slug addition of 3.5 to 10.5 fl. oz. of DB 17 per 1000 gal. of water (30 to 90 ppm DB 17) every 2 to 5 days or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the microbiological problem. Slug additions should be made in the sump of recirculating cooling tower systems.

DB 17 is used in industrial air-washing systems which maintain effective misteliminating components. Prior to its use, systems should be cleaned to remove bacterial slime and other deposits. An initial slug dose of 16.5 to 21.0 fl. oz. of DB 17 per 1000 gal. of water is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is evident. Subsequent slug additions of 12.3 to 21.0 fl. oz. of DB 17 per 1000 gallons of water should be employed every 1 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions may be made to the sump or the water collection trays of the airwash system.

DB 17 is a preservative used to control sulfate-reducing bacteria and slime-forming bacteria that cause the degradation of crude oil and diesel and distillate heating oils during storage. DB 17 should be added to the oil as it is being transferred from the shipping container to the storage tank at the rate of 21-42 ft. bz. DB 17 per 1000 gal, oil. Addition may be made batchwise where mixing occurs or continuously to the suction side of the transfer numb.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited PESTICIDE DISPOSAL.
