



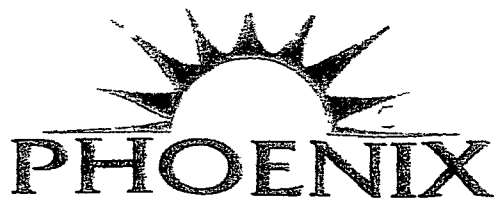

For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of 50 to 77 fluid ounces of **Blizzard Winterizer** per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae. For treatment of freshly cleaned and filled pools, add initially 27 to 50 fluid ounces of **Blizzard Winterizer** per 10,000 gallons of water.

Maintenance Dosage Subsequent additions of 9 to 18 fluid ounces of **Blizzard Winterizer** per 10,000 gallons of water must be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Blizzard Winterizer will prevent growth of most algae during the off season winter months when pools are not in use. For pools which have been properly treated during the swimming season and are free of visible algae, add 27 to 50 fluid ounces of **Blizzard Winterizer** per 10,000 gallons of water. If at the end of swimming season pools have some visible algae growth, add 50 to 77 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of algicide throughout the water and the pool be made for maximum effectiveness. If pool is not covered, it is necessary to repeat treatment during the season.
