The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the Busan 77 RED, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is **not** yet being reregistered under section 4(g) of FIFRA.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

- Basic CSF, dated 8/28/2013
- Alternate CSF 1, dated 8/28/2013

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. Products shipped after 12 months from the date of this amendment or the next printing of the label, whichever occurs first, must bear the new revised label. Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended label constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6.

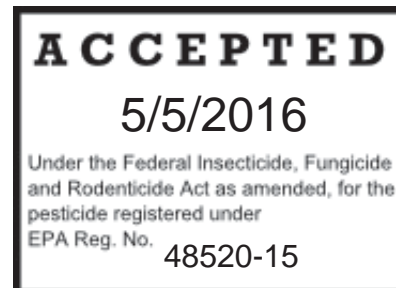

FIRST AID

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through the skin, or inhaled. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Avoid breathing vapors. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, and chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

POLY-30 Algacide is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ornamental ponds. For maximum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth of algae must be shocked and cleaned prior to using **POLY-30 Algacide**.



For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 24 to 37 fluid ounces of **POLY-30** per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae. For treatment of freshly cleaned and filled pools add initially 13 to 24 fluid ounces of **POLY-30** per 10,000 gallons of water.

Maintenance Dosage: Subsequent additions of 4 to 8 fluid ounces of **POLY-30** per 10,000 gallons of water must be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.

[Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains and ponds having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of **POLY-30 Algacide** per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled spa, whirlpool, hot tub, decorative fountain or pond, add initially 1 to 2 fluid ounces of **POLY-30** per 1,000 gallons of water.

Maintenance Dosage: Subsequent additions of 0.5 to 0.8 fluid ounces of **POLY-30** per 1,000 gallons of water must be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.]

POLY-30 Algacide is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. **POLY-30** can be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix **POLY-30** with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

{Optional winter and off-season directions for use}

[WINTERIZING DIRECTIONS

POLY-30 Algacide will prevent growth of most algae during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. For pools which have been properly treated during the swimming season and are free of visible algae, add 12 to 20 fluid ounces of **POLY-30** per 10,000 gallons of water. If at the end of swimming season pools have some visible algae growth, add 24 to 34 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons. For maximum effectiveness, it is necessary to achieve a uniform distribution of algacide throughout the water and the pool. If pool is not covered, it may be necessary to repeat the treatment during the season.]

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

{Residential}

[Keep container closed when not in use. Store in an area inaccessible to children and persons unfamiliar with its use. Leaking or damaged containers



must be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in the trash. Mop up spills with clear water. Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling if available. If not, discard in trash.]

{Nonresidential}

[Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
