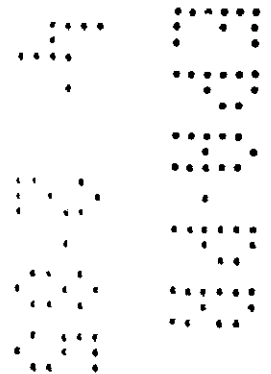

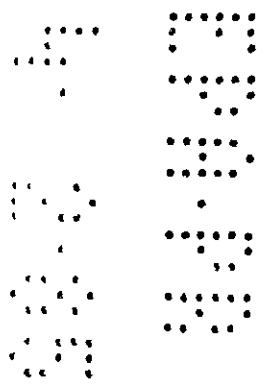
STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT[14bf]

In case of contact with skin, wash immediately with plenty of soap and water. Immediately contact physician.

In case of contact with eyes, flush promptly and thoroughly with clear water for at least 15 minutes. Immediately contact physician.

In case of ingestion, feed gruel, cooked cereal or bread soaked in milk followed by olive oil. Immediately contact physician.

(THIRD PANEL)

INTERMITTENT OR SLUG METHOD

INITIAL DOSE: When the system is noticeably fouled,  
add ER-26 at the rate of 15 to 150 pounds (45 to  
450 ppm) per 1000 barrels of water intermittently for  
4 to 8 hours per day and from 1 to 4 times per week  
or as needed. Repeat until control is achieved.

SUBSEQUENT DOSE: When microbial control is evident,  
add ER-26 at the rate of 15 to 75 pounds (45 to  
225 ppm) per 1000 barrels of water every 3 days or  
as needed to maintain control.

CONTINUOUS FEED METHOD

INITIAL DOSE: When the system is noticeably fouled,  
add ER-26 at the rate of 15 to 150 pounds (45 to  
450 ppm) per 1000 barrels of water in the system. Con-  
tinue until control is achieved.

SUBSEQUENT DOSE: When microbial control is evident,  
continuously feed ER-26 to maintain a dosage of 4.5  
to 75 pounds (15 to 225 ppm) per 1000 barrels of  
water in the system.

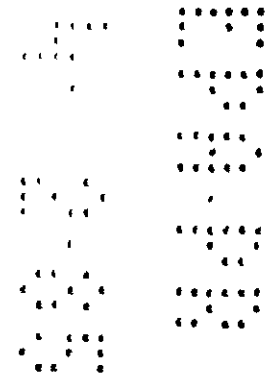
STORAGE AND DISPOSAL[14bf]

STORAGE: Keep container tightly closed. Protect from  
freezing. Store in a dry place. Do not store at ele-  
vated temperatures.

DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by  
storage and disposal.
