INSECTO is intended to be used as a dust. Suitable means to minimize dust when applying INSECTO include equipment.

INSECTO is an effective control for Grain Weevils, Angoumois Grain Weevils, Red Flour Beetles, Shipworms and Stored Grain Beetles. Wheat, Barley, Sorghum, and Sorghum.

INSECTO should be dusted on the feet of all insects. Special attention should be given to areas where insects are likely to be fed with grain. Repeat applications every two to three days may be required to reduce the

INSECTO should be dusted on the accessible surface of bins. Apply INSECTO to the entire surface of the bins. Do not dust grain.

**FOR IN-TRANSIT PESTICIDES**

Do not dust grain. Do not dust workers.

**TREATMENT OF STORAGE**

Apply INSECTO to the surface of the grain. Do not dust grain.
