On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. Make the following label changes:
  - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 48598-3".
  - b. As a result of the Agency's efficacy review (enclosed), label directions requiring "observations at 2 weeks after treatment" and "retreatment at monthly intervals of mounds showing the highest number of satellites" is recommended. Similar wording may be substituted if the intent of the directive is not altered.
  - c. Modify the subheading, "Hazard to Humans" to include, "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals". Directly below this subheading, the signal word "WARNING" must be depicted. Refer to 40 CFR 156.10(h)(2)(i) for further guidance. Also modify this paragraph to include: "Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes. May cause severe eye irritation. Avoid contamination of food and food crops."

d. Change the signal word, "CAUTION" on your label to "WARNING". This modification is required based upon the similarity determination of your product as determined by the Agency.

e. The Storage and Disposal statement should be made part of the Directions for Use.

f. Add an "Environmental Hazards" subheading to your Precautionary Statements to include the following text:

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Drift and runoff from treated sites may be hazardous to fish in adjacent waters.

3. Submit the analytical method (guideline 62-3) for enforcement purposes in accordance with 40 CFR 158.180.

4. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
