Roussel Bio Corporation's letter dated July 30, 1990 providing authorization to the Agency to review all data on file for SBP-1382/ Esbiothrin/Piperonyl Butoxide Insecticide Aerosol 0.2%-0.3%-1.2%, EPA Reg. No. 432-686, in support of the substitution of Esbiothrin for Allethrin for this product.

Dear Mr. Plant:

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. Please make the following label changes on your next set of printed labels:

1. Instead of adding the word "Flammable" at the beginning of the PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS portion of the label, you must list the product as "Extremely Flammable" because your product contains flammable propellants.

2. Add the phrase "Do not puncture or incinerate." to the STORAGE AND DISPOSAL portion of the label.

3. Add the following statements to the PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS portion of the label: " Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. May cause eye or skin irritation. Avoid contact eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.
