The amendments referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, are acceptable subject to the following comments.

1. Since your formulation change is substantial, submit a complete product chemistry data matrix on the new formulation. Be sure to include the flash point of the product with the propellant and the flame extension of the product including flashbacks if noted. Mixtures marketed under ~~entirety to tests indicated in 40 CFR Sec. 156.10(h)(2)(iii) of the~~ maxipackage. (Flash points for pressurized liquids are conveniently measured after collecting the expelled liquid from the container in an open cup chilled with dry ice. See Aerosol Guide, CSMA)

2. The Confidential Statement of Formula dated 6/20/88 is the basic and only formulation for this product.

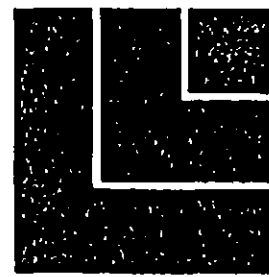
