Dear Mr. Plant:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.


1. Revise the first sentence of the paragraph under HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS to read as follows: "Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation."

This change is required based on the product's classification in category III for acute dermal toxicity and eye irritation potential. [Note: Based on the product's classification in category IV for acute oral toxicity, the "harmful if swallowed" statement is not required; however, you may retain it if you wish.]

2. Delete the last sentence of the paragraph under HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS ("Do not use this or any other pesticide on sick, old, or debilitated animals"). This statement is superseded by PR Notice 96-6 statements that appear elsewhere on the label.
3. You are encouraged to include an emergency, toll-free number as recommended in PR Notice 2001-1.

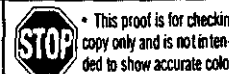
