GENERAL: Read LABEL DIRECTIONS first before using. Use common sense with this product and all pesticides.

HOW TO USE: Simply aim pin stream at insect targets, shooting in rapid, intermittent spurts. Try to stand at least 10 feet away from nests when using this insecticide as wasps, hornets, yellow jackets, etc. may become riled increasing your risk of being stung. If you are afraid of using this product yourself, call a qualified pest control operator. If possible, the best time to use "SWAT" WASP & HORNET JET is in the early evening when these types of insects are less active. This insecticide will also anesthetize, knock down and kill other large and fearsome pests such as palmetto bugs, water bugs, scorpions, black widows, tarantulas, large cockroaches in any outdoor or industrial situation. This is one of the safest Wasp & Hornet Jets to use because the ingredients:

- 1) Have a natural, botanical dual insecticidal action
- 2) Contain a tacky, insecticidal resin making it impossible for struck wasps and hornets to regain their ability to fly.
- 3) Contain an anesthetic that will knock out any struck insect pest.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING: Do not spray directly on food, people or animals. May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing mist. Do not spray towards your face. Remove clothing and wash if it becomes contacted with spray. Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water after using.

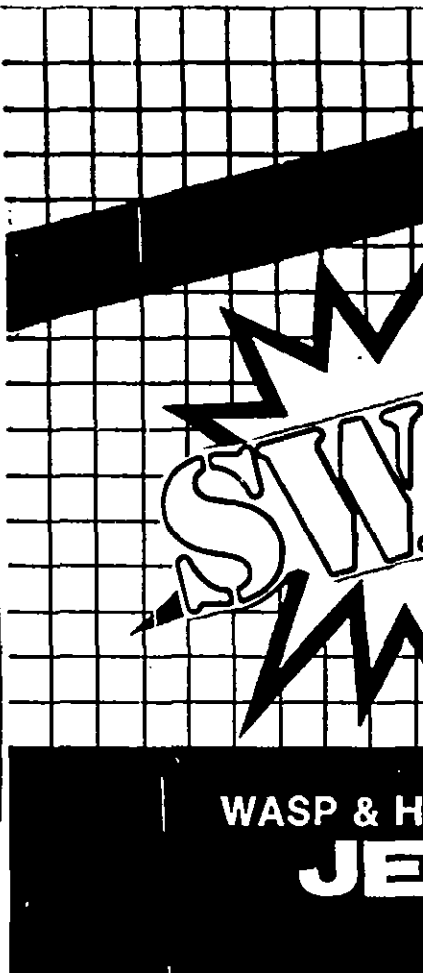
