3. The declaration of the active ingredient, dimethothiaz, in the ingredient statement must be changed to:

2,2-dimethyl-2-oxo-1,3-dioxane
3,3-(2,2-dimethyl-3-(2-methylpropyl)cyclopropanecarboxylate 2.00%

Note that all amounts are now combined into one percentage.

4. Submit a 1 year storage stability study. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredient at time zero and for 1 year of storage. The storage must be under warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity using containers similar to those that will be used in the trade. These data must be submitted within 15 months of the date of this Registration Notice.

5. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE ON AIRCRAFT

To Kill Mosquitoes, Gnats, House Flies, Fruit Flies: Use while aircraft is in flight or on ground prior to takeoff. Use at least 30 minutes prior to landing. Stop ventilation system for a period of not less than 3 minutes after spraying. Spray 10 grams (10 seconds) per 1000 cubic feet. Push button to spray. Move arm from side in a sweeping motion. Spray all surfaces.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN BUILDINGS, VANS, SHIPS, AND IN TENTAGE FOR INDOOR USE ONLY

For Use By Department of Defense Personnel Only

To Kill Flying Insects (Mosquitoes, House Flies and Gnats): Close space to be treated. Release 3 feet from any surface, holding dispenser above the head. Moving the dispenser about while spraying aids in dispense only for time indicated. Ten seconds of spraying is ample for each 1,000 cubic feet (10 feet x 10 feet x 10 feet). Keep treated area closed at least 30 minutes. Ventilate area before re-entry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Cockroaches, Fleas, Lice, Ticks and other crawling insects: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thoroughly spraying all parts of the room suspected of harboring insects. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces and where these pests are suspected of hiding.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDOUS TO HUMANS CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Do not use in commercial food serving areas while food is exposed. Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS
